### How to Get Started

- With a \$1,000 initial commitment and the promise that at least \$9,000 will follow in your estate a named fund will be started for you - this allows you to contribute during your lifetime as well, if you choose.
- The named fund can be designated how you choose:

  - One of our (6) granting areas: Arts & Culture, Education, the Environment, Sports & Recreation, Social Services or Health
  - Continued operation of the PGCF
